

Accessing State Brownfields Resources

We at the Colorado Brownfields Partnership are experts in helping Colorado communities envision, learn, and plan for the future of their brownfields and community. But once that work is done, we know that applying for state assistance is a key step towards brownfield revitalization success. Through our process, local government entities (or private property owners in partnership with them) and non-profits can receive assistance from the Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE), such as a free Targeted Brownfields Assessment that would otherwise cost upwards of \$12,000. This process also assures CDPHE cleanup plan approval and liability relief to brownfield property owners.

The flowchart below is a visual process that communities will go through with CDPHE to get brownfield sites cleaned and ready for use.
